John began as a firefighter in 1972 prior to graduation from Oklahoma State University in 1973 with a BS degree in Forestry. He began serving on National Type 1 Incident Management Teams in the early 1980s. His background/experience is Type 1 Command, Operations and Plans. He served as Incident Commander for an NGO team organizing Haitian churches to be the direct rescue and care mechanism for orphans immediately following the 2010 earthquake.
